TACKLING ORGANISED EXPLOITATION PROGRAMME

TOEX continues to develop and assess new technical capabilities in the fight against organised exploitation. Some of these tools are suitable for wider application across policing – with national IT hosting arranged so they can be leveraged for universal tactical & strategic purpose.

Savings

TOEX tools/apps provide invaluable time-saving aids

for policing investigations, building efficiencies and facilitating the discovery of **previously unknown insight**. A constabulary quoted £2,000 for manual translation of 6,000 lines of Iraqi text and a time envelope of two weeks. TOEX completed the task in

under five minutes for £0.83 pence.

Collaboration & Impact

TOEX works with other national organisations/portfolios to address any gaps in the response to high-harm threats, as identified by the Strategic Policing Requirement, ministerial priorities and HMICFRS.
TOEX collaborates with industry and wider UKLE partners when innovating technical enablers that respond to organised exploitation threats.
From 2024, Police Digital Service will begin to host some TOEX Capabilities on their Shared Services platform for UKLE access, with Translation as the first application.
TOEX has skilled resources that leverage data to focus on high-harm offenders/victims; fill intelligence gaps; support effective force investigations & enrich strategic understanding.
TOEX is part of the national CSE Taskforce, combining effort with VKPP and Hydrant in the disruption of group-based CSE.
TOEX model data to identify hot-spots of online CSAE abuse to facilitate targeted UCOL deployment.

TOEX deliver **operational threat profiles** including VAWG, Missing Persons and ViSOR to 9 Forces in the current Data Platform - identifying individuals requiring intervention and tackling risk.
